GENERAL NOTES

- Keep these operating instructions within easy reach near the unit.
- The manufacturer/dealer cannot be held responsible for damage caused by failure to observe these operating instructions.
- If these operating instructions are not observed, the safety of the unit can no longer be guaranteed.
- If the unit is passed on to third parties, these operating instructions must also be handed over.
- This appliance must not be operated by children or persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities as burns may occur.
- After unpacking the unit, make sure that everything is in perfect condition. If you discover any damage, notify your dealer.
- Check whether all components specified in the scope of delivery are present. If this is not the case, inform your dealer.
- Keep the packaging of the unit. The unit can only be transported safely in its original packaging, e.g. for repair
 purposes, when moving house, etc. Note that all components of the packaging (plastic bags, cardboard, polystyrene
 parts, etc.) can endanger children and must therefore not be stored near them.
- If it is not possible to store the packaging, separate the different packaging materials and deliver them to the nearest collection point for proper disposal.
- Do not operate the unit unattended.
- Observe the accident prevention regulations and general safety regulations applicable to the area of use.
- Place the unit in a dry, adequately ventilated place and on a straight, safe surface.
- Do not drill or pierce holes in the inside or outside of the unit.
- The manufacturer/dealer cannot be held responsible for damage caused by failure to observe the operating instructions. Likewise, the safety of the unit is no longer guaranteed.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Incorrect operation and improper handling can lead to malfunctions of the unit and injury to the user.
- Observe the accident prevention regulations and general safety regulations applicable to the area of use.
- Ensure that the unit stands securely on a dry, non-slip surface that is adequate for the weight of the unit.
- Do not expose the appliance to direct sunlight, do not place it near other heat sources (heater, cooker, oven... open fire) and/or do not place it on a hot surface.
- Do not store highly flammable or explosive substances near the unit.
 - Do not work with highly flammable substances in the vicinity of the unit (no spray paint or similar).
- Do not place heavy objects, loads or liquids on the unit.
- Do not move the unit during use.
- Make sure that the unit does not tilt when moving. This could lead to injuries.
- A damaged unit must not be used!
- For hygienic reasons, at least daily cleaning is recommended, but also in the course of a day if necessary.
- For storage, fold the feet away to the inside.
- Do not drink directly from the drain tap.

DEVICE INSTALLATION

Set up the unit in a dry and sufficiently ventilated room. Ensure that the unit stands securely on a dry and non-slip surface.

Fold out the feet for a secure stand.

STRUCTURE AND PARTS



FIRST COMMISSIONING

Before first use:

Unpack the appliance, check that it is complete and set it up (see Setting up the appliance). Clean the appliance (see Cleaning).

OPERATION - SETTINGS

- Rinse thoroughly with hot water before use
- Place the unit on a flat surface and fold the feet outwards, until they click into place.
- Fill with the liquid of your choice, only to a maximum of 2 cm below the rim of the container.
- Do not fill hot milk products or carbonated drinks into the dispenser.
- To pour, fix the tap in the open position or operate it individually.

CLEANING

Wipe the outside and inside with a damp, soft cloth.

A mild washing-up liquid can be used for this purpose.

Wipe again without cleaning additive, then rub dry well.

Do not use abrasive, bleaching, corrosive or scratching cleaning agents/cleaning aids, as this could damage/scratch the surfaces.

MAINTENANCE

The beverage dispenser requires very little maintenance. Note the points under installation and cleaning.

BEVERAGE DISPENSER TAKE OUT OF SERVICE / STORAGE / TRANSPORTATION

Clean the unit thoroughly inside and out. If it is dry and the unit is not to be used for a longer period of time, store it in a dry, dust-free and not hot place. It is best to cover the unit or use the original packaging to protect the unit from damage. Secure the unit against pets climbing in, so that they cannot be trapped there.

When storing only the packaging material, please note that components of the packaging such as plastic bags, cardboard, polystyrene parts, etc., can be dangerous for children if they play with them unsupervised (e.g. choking hazard). can endanger children if they play with them unsupervised (e.g. choking hazard).


When transporting the unit, it is best to use the original packaging so that the unit is optimally protected against impact, sharp edges, weather conditions, etc. Do not expose it to moisture or rain.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If the appliance does not keep warm properly, check that the lid is closed.

If a smaller quantity of liquid comes out of the tap, clean the tap
